

## MARIA HASSABI

In "Still Smoking," the up-and-coming choreographer's new evening-length work, the focus is on urban alienation: a girl stands alone onstage, loudly vocalizing while five others stride purposefully in other directions. As they swarm about, one dancer's motion is picked up seconds later by another; it's as if the same signals are always in the air, but the dancers' antennae work differently. Later, when the mismatched downtown crew starts waving arms to a feel-good groove, it's like watching the cast of "Rent" in "Fame." Hassabi works with an eyecatching movement vocabulary—equal parts sidewalk and catwalk, bedroom and club. (The Kitchen, 512 W. 19th St. 212-255-5793.
