The New York dance scene seems to lurch violently from summer famine to autumnal feast; this week holds numerous appealing prospects. Among them is MARIA HASSABI's "Solo," the first in a diptych commissioned by the Crossing the Line festival, Performa 09 and Performance Space 122. In her "Gloria" (2007) Ms. Hassabi, born in Cyprus, created a powerfully theatrical environment from not much more than two women moving through a series of isolated poses, the noise of downtown Athens, and Joe Levasseur's magical lighting. Her new work (also lighted by Mr. Levasseur) takes place on a Persian carpet; perhaps she will transport us again.
